Over/Under 50 Doubles Tournament Rules

Tournament Description: Tournament is sponsored by the Tuscaloosa USBC Association and certified by USBC. Format is doubles, with one bowler being age 50 years and above and the other bowler being under 50 years of age.

Tournament Date/Time: *Sunday*, November 13, 2022. Start time is 2:00 pm, with check-in at 1:15 pm.

Tournament Location: **Bowlero Tuscaloosa**

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per bowler or \$50.00 per doubles team. \$10 for alibis (additional doubles partner).

Entries Closed: Participants may sign up during tournament check-in time.

1. **PARTICIPANTS** – The tournament format is three games of handicap doubles, with teams consisting of one bowler aged 50 years and above and the other bowler under 50 years of age. All participants must be current USBC members. Youth league bowlers are not eligible to participate.
2. **ENTRY FEE/PRIZE FUND** – Entry fee is \$25 per bowler, with \$15 for lineage/expenses and \$10 going into the prize fund. Prize money will be paid out based on a payout ratio of at least 1 place for every 10 entries.
3. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION** – Multiple participation is allowed—a bowler may compete with more than one partner. Bowler pays full \$25 entry fee for first entry, then \$10 for each additional entry.
4. **ENTERING AVERAGES** – Entrants will use their highest USBC sanctioned book average for the previous season—summer or winter. Bowlers without a previous season average will use their highest current season average of at least 21 games on the tournament date. Bowlers without a current average will be required to bowl with a 220 average. The 10-pin rule does not apply (USBC Rule 319a2). Rules 319d and 319e are waived.
5. **HANDICAP** – Based on 90% of 220.
6. **PROBLEMS/DISPUTES** – Any problems and/or disputes which may occur and are not covered by these tournament rules or USBC rules shall be decided upon by the Tournament Committee.
7. **TOURNAMENT DISRUPTION** – Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto or therefrom fire, natural disaster, or any other reason beyond the control of the Tuscaloosa USBC shall cause, to the extent required thereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in the respective event up to the time of such termination.
8. **PROTESTS** – Protests involving eligibility or playing rules must be made to tournament management in writing within time limits in Rule 329.
